- Meaning of Pentateuch (Pen·ta·teuch – [ˈpen(t)ə,t(y)oo̯k]): The first five books of the Hebrew Bible (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy). Traditionally ascribed to Moses, it is now held by scholars to be a compilation from texts of the 9th to 5th centuries BC. Jewish name Torah.
