- *Holy convocation* (singular or plural) is used repeatedly in this passage; it appears in verses 2-4 and 7-8. Also, the word is found in verses [21](#), [27](#), and verses [35-37](#) in this chapter. The Hebrew word for convocation is *MIKRAW*, meaning a *rehearsal*, also *to read and understand*.
- The word *holy* is pronounced *KAWDASH* in the Hebrew, and means *set apart* or *sanctify*.
- This is an emphasis that God’s plan is for us to be *sanctified, set apart*, and God wants us to *read and understand* what He has to say to us.
