Introduction: Leviticus – All About Jesus

Reading: Leviticus 23:1-11

- Holy convocation (singular or plural) is used repeatedly in this passage; it appears in verses 2-4 and 7-8. Also, the word is found in verses 21, 27, and verses 35-37 in this chapter. The Hebrew word for convocation is MIKRAW, meaning a rehearsal, also to read and understand.
- The word *holy* is pronounced *KAWDASH* in the Hebrew, and means *set apart* or *sanctify*.
- This is an emphasis that God's plan is for us to be *sanctified, set apart,* and God wants us to *read and understand* what He has to say to us.
