Reference Material:

- Greek / Literal Translations: [Hebrews 13:8](#), [Hebrews 13:7](#) – Consistency: everything in life worth having demands *consistency*. Jesus Christ was consistent in every way
- Jesus (*Jesus*) – *HUMANITY*; Christ (*Christos*) – *MISSION*; Lord (*Kurios*) – *DEITY*. When *LORD* is written first, *deity* is emphasized; *JESUS* first means *humanity* is the emphasis; *CHRIST* first means the emphasis is *His mission*.

- Look again at the Greek in [Hebrews 13:8](#). Jesus Christ remains in hypostatic union forever as a memorial of His victory in the conflict of the ages.
- John 19:28 ([Greek / Literal Translation](#)) - When Jesus said “I thirst” this was an emphasis on His humanity. TETELESTAI – translated *accomplished* or *finished* in the perfect passive indicative means that His work on earth was finished with results that would continue forever.
