Review: Last 4 Sessions

1. Attention was given to the activity of the Holy Spirit in the age of Israel.
2. Then we considered what God’s Word declares of how important it is for us to use our tongues properly.
3. Next, how our Heavenly Father desires that we *TAME OUR TONGUES*.
4. Before going back to the Old Testament and the book of Hosea, we now consider the important subject of *“Judging Right or Wrong”*, from Matthew 7:1 and John 7:24.

Pastor’s Detour: When we came to the close of our study in the Book of Daniel, under the category *“Jesus in Every Book of the Old Testament”*, we took a 4-session detour, which concludes tonight. Next Sunday, we move into the Book of Hosea.

Note four pertinent scriptures for tonight:

Ecclesiastes 3:7 – *“A time to tear, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;”*

Exodus 14:14 – *“The Lord will fight for you and you have only to be silent.”*

Psalms 37:30 – *“The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom, and his tongue speaks justice.”*

Proverbs 26:20 – *“For lack of wood the fire goes out, and where there is no whisperer, quarreling ceases.”*
