At Salvation What Happens?

John 3:16ff

- I. At salvation, God gives His absolute Righteousness to the new believer.
- II. The new believer becomes a child of God and member of the Royal Family.
- III. The Lord Jesus Christ is God's Right Man and the Bride is the Church.
- IV. The new believer in the church age becomes a member of the Church Universal, which is called the body of Christ.
- V. At the moment of salvation, the believer is baptized by the Holy Spirit, whereby the Holy Spirit enters the new believer into union with Christ. Because of the believer's new position in Christ, he shares Christ's inheritance and Righteousness, and he has eternal security so that he can never lose his salvation.
- VI. At salvation, the Holy Spirit creates in the believer's body a temple for the indwelling of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- VII. Never before in history has the Holy Spirit indwelt anyone other than Jesus Christ in Hypostatic Union. At this time the believer is given many invisible assets for time and eternity.
