

Bible Subjects

ADOPTION – Places us in a new position with the Father; we are not just followers or friends of God, we are sons and daughters – children of God; we have all the privileges and rights of His Royal Family. John 1:12, 13; Rom. 8:15, 23; Rom. 9:4; Eph. 1:5

ANGELOLOGY – The doctrine of angels.

ANTHROPOLOGY – The doctrine of man.

ANTHROPOMORPHISM – Ascribing to God, physical properties and human form which he does not have. IE: eyes of God, arm of God, to anything non-human

ANTHROPOPATHISM – Ascribing to God, human characteristics which he does not have. It is divine thoughts in human terminology

ANTI-SEMITISM - The hostility in thought or action against the Jews.

BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (BHS) – The Holy Spirit takes believers at the moment of salvation and enters them into union with Christ. 1 Cor. 12:13.

BELIEVER – A person who has received Christ as personal Savior. John 1:12.

BIBLIOLOGY – Doctrine of the Bible.

CANON - The books of the Bible recognized as genuine and inspired of God.

CARNALITY - The state of a believer controlled by the old sin nature (**OSN**).

DEITY – The character or nature of God.

DEITY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (DHS) – By DHS, WE MEAN THAT THE Holy Spirit (Deity 3 of the Godhead) is one with God and one in the Godhead. He is co-equal, co-eternal and con-substantial (one in substance, essence and nature) with God the Father (Deity 1) and God the Son (Deity 2).

DEMONOLOGY – The doctrine of demons (fallen angels).

Bible Subjects (Continued)

DISPENSATIONS – Divine categories, and/or the divine outline of human history expressed in terms of divine revelation. A period of time as God sees human history. In each age, God operates through an agency, such as Israel or the Church. A period of time as God sees human history.

DIVINE ESSENCE – The characteristics or attributes of the Godhead. What God is like.

DOCTRINE – Categories of Biblical information related to the plan of God.

ECCLESIOLOGY – The doctrine of the Church “ekklesia”.

ESCHATOLOGY – The doctrine of the “last things”.

ETERNAL PLAN OF GOD (EPOG) – This is the sum total of God’s plan for the human race. It is the eternal scheme of all things adopted by the Divine Mind which embraces all of His original designs including everything in the creative and redemptive PROTHESIS (pre-determined plan) of God. It is His eternal, holy, wise and sovereign purpose for the human race. This plan centers in Christ and has only one entrance – GRACE! I John 3:22-24; Eph. 1:4-6; Isa. 14:26, 27; Isa. 46:10, 11

EXPIATION – The removal of the penalty of sin.

FILLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (FHS) – This is the means by which a Christian is **cleansed of sin (COS)**, Christ controlled and prepared for the reception, absorption, assimilation, appropriation and application of the Word of God. The Christian life is a HUMAN IMPOSSIBILITY. Therefore, when a person is controlled by the Holy Spirit, he is controlled by a power greater than man, That power is absolutely necessary to break the hold of the flesh which the Bible calls CARNALITY.

FORGIVENESS – The putting away of sins. Eph. 1:6-7; Col. 1:12-14.

GNOSTICISM – False teaching which tries to reconcile Bible doctrine, philosophy, heathenism and Judaism. It claims all matter is evil.

GRACE – All that is free to do for man on the basis of the cross. It is the title of God’s plan for mankind.

GRACE ABOUNDING LIFE (GAL) – The GAL is the step beyond Christian Maturity (I John 1:4; I Thess. 5:16) and is God’s plan for every born-again believer. Results of living in the GAL include: inner happiness, stability, and great love and appreciation for the Lord Jesus Christ. Col. 3:12; Heb. 12:2

GRACE SYSTEM OF COMPREHENSION (GSC) – The provision of God whereby EVERY believer can understand the Word of God, regardless of education or human I.Q. Col. 1:9; Eph. 1:18

Bible Subjects (Continued)

HARMARTIOLOGY – The doctrine of sin.

HEATHENISM – An area where the Gospel has been preached and rejected.

HEAVENS GRACE BLESSINGS - (HGB) refers to the special blessings and rewards belonging to the grace abounding (**GA**) believer in eternity. A GA believer is one who has advanced past base 1 and 2 and reached base 3, the Echo Zone and is having and holding the truth of God more real and important than anything in temporal life.

HOLINESS – “Saint”, “sanctify” and “holy” all come from the same Greek word and mean “to set apart” or “to be set apart”. Jesus Christ is set apart unto God, and since we are in Christ, we are set apart also, unto God.

HUMANITY – The character or nature of man. Jesus Christ is perfect and true humanity.

IMMUTABLE – Unchangeable and faithful character of God.

IMPUTATION – The act of God whereby He credits perfect righteousness to the believer.

INCARNATION – God, becoming flesh and taking the form of man – Jesus.

INDWELLING - At the moment of Salvation, every believer is indwelt by God the Holy Spirit; that is, the Holy Spirit takes up permanent residence in the believer [1 Corinthians 6:19 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;].

INDWELLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (IHS)- At the moment of salvation, every believer is indwelt by God the Holy Spirit; that is, the Holy Spirit takes up permanent residence in the believer. 1 Cor. 6:19

INSPIRATION – God so supernaturally directed the writers of Scripture that without waiving their human intelligence, literary style, or personal feelings, or any other human factor, His complete and coherent message to man was recorded with perfect accuracy, the very words of the original Scripture bearing the authority of divine authorship.

JUDGMENT – The application of the divine justice of God in judicial sentences, decisions and in punishment.

JUSTIFICATION – Imputed righteousness; our position in Christ; a change of standing; to vindicate or acquit.

LEGALISM – Any attempt to win God’s favor or become righteous by human merit or works. It applies to both salvation and sanctification of the believer. Mark 7: 1-13; 33-39; Mark 3:3-5

MEDIATOR – One who is equal with both parties of a mediation and therefore qualified to act as a go-between.

Bible Subjects (Continued)

MILLENNIUM – The last dispensation in time, the Kingdom-Age. It is the period of time when Christ will reign on the earth for a thousand years. Rev. 20

NECROMANCY - This is an attempt to contact the dead for information.

NEW BIRTH (NB) – Also known as REGENERATION. This is the supernatural work of God whereby a person is the recipient of everlasting life imparted from God the Father (Deity 1), through the work of Jesus Christ His Son (Deity 2) on the Cross, by the agency of the Holy Spirit (Deity 3). John 3:1-21

OLD SIN NATURE (OSN) – Also called the “old man” of Ephesians 4:22, and the Adamic nature of “flesh” of Romans 8:3-4. This is the principle of sin which is passed down from father to child. (Isa. 51:5) The **OSN** has an area of weakness which produces personal sins; and an area of strength which produces works of the flesh (**WOF**). The **OSN** also has patterns of lust which trend either toward asceticism and lasciviousness.

PNEUMATOLOGY – The doctrine of the person and work of the Holy Spirit.

REGENERATION – Makes us partakers of the Divine Nature; our condition through Christ; change in nature. Titus 3:5

RELIGION – Man, by his own efforts, trying to gain salvation or the favor of God.

RTF - RESTORATION TO FELLOWSHIP – The believer’s being restored to harmony and a right relationship with God through the application of I John 1:9, which is the confession or naming of sins.

SANCTIFICATION – It is to make holy; to set apart; the action of the Holy Spirit in making the believer holy; filling of the Holy Spirit, walking in the Spirit.

Positional Sanctification – Occurs at salvation. 1 Cor. 1:2; Heb. 10:10; Col. 2:10. We are set apart “in Christ”. We are partakers of the Divine nature.

Experiential Sanctification – Identification. Eph. 5:26 which means “in fellowship”. Filled with the Holy Spirit. (**FHS**)
1 John 3:1-2

Ultimate Sanctification – The believer in eternity. Phil. 3:21; 1 Thess. 5:23; 1 John 3:1-2. We are assured of a resurrection body. We shall live in His presence forever. “Holiness”, “saint”, “sanctify” and “holy” all come from the same Greek word and it means “to set apart” or “to be set apart”. Jesus Christ is set apart unto God, and since we are in Christ, we are set apart also unto God.

Bible Subjects (Continued)

SPIRITUALITY – (The Abundant Life) Christ controlling the life by repeated (habitual) filling of the Holy Spirit.
