

## Brief Overview of Ephesians 2:8

*For (γάρ) now you see grace (For by Grace)*

- At the Cross we see GRACE.
- Grace puts us in proper relationship with God.
- Grace gives Victory at all times. *YOU HAVE BEEN SAVED* – FfPP of σοζο *sozo* – permanently.
- The mechanics of the plan are outlined, but the *PLANNER COMES FIRST*. When we really comprehend the *PLANNER*, we will have no difficulty with the mechanics of the *PLAN!*
- This is saying that we are completely and permanently saved through *FAITH*. “*And this*” *ENTIRE PLAN IS NOT OF YOURSELVES (NOT – Negative adverb)*.
- *Ou; ouk; ouch* – The word that follows (specifically, it’s 1<sup>st</sup> letter) reveals the strength of a negative adverb. If it is ...
  - *ouk* οὐκ – 1<sup>st</sup> letter that follows is a vowel
  - *ou* ου – 1<sup>st</sup> letter that follows is a consonant
  - *ouch* ουξ is used before vowels with a rough breathing mark

Not out from the source of you all (gen. pl., 2<sup>nd</sup> p. personal pronoun) *ouk exz* οὐκ ἐξ ὁμῶν

*Now you see by the grace, you have been completely and permanently saved through FAITH, even this is not out from the source of you all – from God the free GIFT (never to be earned or deserved).*
