## <u>Church</u>

## **John 14:16 (Comforter** – παράκλητος**)**

John 14:20 "At that day (Pentecost) you shall know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you." (This is a prophecy of the Indwelling Christ.)

- I. The church is the place for the dissemination of Spiritual soul food.
- II. The original churches met in homes.
- III. The church was established for the purpose of spiritual advancement.
- IV. God has ordained that there be a shepherd-teacher for the local congregation.
- V. When a congregation has grown consistently over a period of years, the forms of worship will be manifested:
  - 1. Grace Orientation
  - 2. Gratitude
  - 3. Witnessing
  - 4. Giving
  - 5. Teaching
  - 6. Service Individual spiritual gifts will be functioning
- VI. The word "church" (ἐκκλησία) is used five ways in God's Word:
  - 1. Citizens gathering for political affairs, legislative meetings. Acts 19:25, 29, 32.
  - 2. In the OT, the word was used for the assembly of Israel. Acts 7:38

## <u>Church</u> (Continued)

- 3. There is a reference to the synagogue as the  $\epsilon \kappa \kappa \lambda \epsilon \sigma i \alpha$  in Matt. 18:17. Jews met to worship. The church actually did not exist at that time.
- 4. The body of Christ is made up of all believers Church Universal revealed in Eph. 1:22, 23; 5:25-27; Col. 1:17, 18.
- 5. The church is used to mean a local group. This is the geographical, visible church made up of believers and unbelievers. I Cor. 1:2; I Thess. 1:1.
- VII. The church began on the day of Pentecost and terminates with the Rapture. | Thess. 4:13-18; | John 3:1, 2; John 14:1-3
- VIII. The mystery character of the church is depicted in the Epistles Eph. 3:1-6; Col. 1:25, 26; Rom. 16:25, 26. Mystery does not mean unknown, but hidden in the past (OT) but now revealed.
  - IX. Born-again Jews on the day of Pentecost were placed in union with Jesus Christ and baptized with the Holy Spirit. Acts 1:5; John 7:39. At the departure of Christ (Ascension) the Church actually began.
  - X. The church age ends with the Rapture of the Royal family. The following verses show that at the Second Advent, the church will come back to the earth with Christ: I Thess. 4:13-18; Col. 2:14, 15 compared to Rev. 19:6-8; Zech. 13:2, I Thess. 3:13. At the end of the church age the Bride – in resurrected body will be glorified, just as at the beginning of the church age, Christ – in resurrected body was glorified.
