<u>Day</u>

- I. An advanced believer considers every day as a Gift from God. Romans 14:5-8: specifically Vs. 5 "One man regards one day above another, another regards every day alike. Let each man be fully convinced in his own mind." Vs. 6 "He who observes the day, observes it for the Lord, and he who eats, does so for the Lord, for he gives thanks to God, and he who eats not, for the Lord he does not eat, and gives thanks to God." Vs. 7 "For not one of us lives for himself, and not one dies for himself;" Vs. 8 "For if we live, we live for the Lord, or if we die, we die for the Lord; therefore whether we live or die, we are the Lord's."
- II. Only the believer has the provisions to purchase (fully & completely) each day allowed, to purchase time. James 4:6 reveals that the capital for purchasing time is called GREATER GRACE. "But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, God is opposed to the proud, but gives Grace to the humble."
 - Read I Corinthians 2:9-16. Life is short and each day we have is a gift of grace. Psalm 90:12 "Teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom." "Life is a vapor." James 4:13-15 (Read)
- III. Another day for us pictures God's faithfulness to us Lamentations 3:22, 23 "It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not." Vs.23 "They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness."
- IV. God has provided CASH to redeem each day. Jer. 15:16 "Thy Words were discovered and acquired (found) and I did devour (eat) them; and thy word was unto me the Joy and rejoicing of my heart; for I am called by thy name, O Lord God of hosts." Matt. 4:4 Jesus spoke to Satan, "It is written (it has been written in the past with the results still standing) man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God."

Day (Continued)

- V. Every day is a Special day John 11:9, 10 "Jesus answered, are there not twelve hours in the day? If any man walks in the day, he stumbles not, because he sees the light of this world." Vs.10 "But if a man walks in the night, he stumbles, because there is no light in him."
 - ➤ Walking living one day at a time in Harmony!
 - > "Does not stumble" (PAI) not offended, not hypersensitive.
 - ▶ He sees the light of the world Occupied with Christ (OWC).
 "Walking in the darkness" means out of harmony I John 1:6, 7 "If (3rd class) we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth."
 Vs. 7 "But if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin." I John 2:10, 11: "The one who loves his brother abides in the light and there is no cause for stumbling in him." Vs. 11 "But the one who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness and does not know where he is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes."
- VI. We are to avoid mental sins because they bring misery! Prov. 27:1 "Boast not thy self of tomorrow; for you do not know what a day may bring forth." Psalm 102:1-3 "Bless the Lord O My Soul and all that is within me, bless His Holy name, Bless the Lord O My soul and forget not all His benefits."
