### **EPHESIANS 3:2 (SUMMARY)**

1. Paul taught “dispensation of Grace.” (οἰκονομίαν) house/law = law of the house – management.
2. The Christians in Ephesus had come to a classroom to be taught Biblical management, divine revelation, categories of human history. They were to learn God’s plan for mankind as well as having an insight as to understanding the Father’s timing in man’s activities in life.
3. The first class conditional clause points to the fact that these believers had heard and responded. People can hear, understand and respond negatively or positively.
