

Ephesians 3:6 - Summary

That the Gentiles should be “*joint-heirs*” because of the Baptism of the HS and positional sanctification, every Gentile believer in the Church Age is in union with Christ and co-equal with all Jewish Christians. This was a real shock to the Jews.

Note: Characteristics of Gentiles in the Church age:

1. Fellow heirs – *sun-klero-nomos* = same opportunity as others (the blessings of royalty).
2. Same body – *sus-soma* – all believers in the church age are priests.
3. Joint possessors – “sharers” share the same account – (The Jew and Gentile draws on the same account.) *The GOSPEL IS presented to ALL*. In the church age, the Gospel is the means by which Jew and Gentile have equal spiritual privileges in believing.
