<u>Ephesians 4:8 – Exegesis and Summary</u>

Wherefore he says, Having ascended διὸ λέγει (PAI 3^{rd} p.s. of λέγω) ἀναβὰς to the heights, He led captives εἰς ὑψος ῃχμαλώτευσέν (AAI 3^{rd} s. αίχμαλωτεύω) In a triumphal procession from a (ascension of Old Testament saints) αἰχμαλωσίαν state of captivity (from Paradise), and gave ἔδωκεν (AAI 3^{rd} p.s. of δίδωμι) gifts unto men. δόματα τοῖς ἀνθρώποις

HERE WE SEE THE ROYAL FAMILY AND VICTORY IN THE DEVIL'S WORLD! $\delta\iota\sigma$ is a conjunction – Ps. 68:18 is quoted here in Ephesians 4:8. The word ἀναβαίνω refers to the Ascension of the Lord Jesus Christ.

REVIEW THE ASCENSION:

"He led captives from the state of captivity" – in a triumphal procession. THESE WERE ALL THE SOULS OF OT SAINTS (HAVING DIED) WHO ARE IN PARADISE (TIME OF THE ASCENSION) (ABRAHAM'S BOSOM – read Luke 18:16-31) and moved from Paradise to Heaven. They are called "captives" because they do not have a resurrection body and will not until the Second Advent. (They are caught with their bodies off). They are a part of the age of Israel.

Note: All OT saints resided in Abraham's bosom, Paradise until the Ascension. They stayed there until Christ was risen – Luke 23:39-45 "Today" Luke 16:10-31; Abraham's bosom Luke 16:22; Matthew 27:52, 53.

We see another facet of Christ's activity in *Sheol* (in the Hebrew), or *Hades* (in the Greek) – I Peter 3:18-22. The following three places are listed in the Scripture as the "heart of the earth":

- 1. Paradise, or Abraham's bosom the abiding place of the souls of departed Old Testament believers before the Ascension.
- 2. "Great gulf fixed" the place called "torments", a place of lost souls.
- 3. The third place, called "tartarus", incarcerates certain fallen angels of Genesis 6.

Abraham's bosom (Paradise) was emptied when God said to our Lord: "SIT THOU AT MY RIGHT HAND". Review again Ephesians 4:8.
