## **EZ Scriptures**

- 1. Rom. 6:4 "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk (AASubj  $1^{st}$  p.pl of  $\pi \in \rho \iota \pi \acute{\alpha} \tau \in \omega$ ) in newness of life."
- 2. Eph. 4:1 "I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that you walk (AAInf) worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called."
- 3. Col. 1:10 "That you might walk (AAInf) worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God."
- 4. Rom. 13:13 "Let us walk περιπατήωμεν--(FASubj. 1<sup>st</sup> p.pl. pf περιπάτεω)honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness (rioting is κώμοις—excessive feastings, partying drunkenness is the Greek word μέθαις = drunken bouts) not in chambering (Greek word koitais-bed μὴ κοίταις=Sex) and excesses (wantonness ἀσελγείαις) not in strife and envying."
- 5. Eph. 2:10 "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk (AASubj.  $1^{st}$  pl.  $\pi$ ερι $\pi$ άτεω) in them."
- 6. 2 Cor. 5:7 "For we walk (PAI 1st p.pl) by faith, not by sight."
- 7. Eph. 5:2 "And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor."
- 8. Gal. 5:16 "Walk (PAImp) in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh."
- 9. Col. 4:5 "Walk (PAImp 2<sup>nd</sup> p.pl of  $\pi$ εριπάτεω) in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time."
