Faith – Greek

In the Greek language of the New Testament, there are five words which are rendered "faith" (in the King James Version).

They are:

pistis, π ιστίς noun, meaning "faith, reliable, that which is believed" pistos, π ιστός adjective, meaning "dependable, inspiring of trust, believing"

pisteuo, πιστένω verb, meaning "to believe; to be convinced" peitho, πείθω verb, meaning "to obey in present tense; to be persuaded in aorist tense; to have confidence in perfect tense"; faith (all tenses)

πιστόω *pistoo*, verb, meaning "to show oneself faithful, to feel confidence"
