

Faith – Greek

In the Greek language of the New Testament, there are five words which are rendered “*faith*” (in the King James Version).

They are:

pistis, πιστίς noun, meaning “*faith, reliable, that which is believed*”

pistos, πιστός adjective, meaning “*dependable, inspiring of trust, believing*”

pisteuo, πιστεύω verb, meaning “*to believe; to be convinced*”

peitho, πείθω verb, meaning “*to obey in present tense; to be persuaded in aorist tense; to have confidence in perfect tense*”; faith (all tenses)

πιστόω *pistoo*, verb, meaning “*to show oneself faithful, to feel confidence*”
