<u>Gnosticism</u>

- I. Gnosis γνόσις knowledge
- II. Gnosticism Defined A major trust of Satan, which combines Greek philosophy, legalistic Judaism and Oriental dualism, all being covered with a Christian vocabulary. It's a blend of religion, philosophy and culture.
- III. Gnosticism caused Paul to develop a technical vocabulary to describe certain principles of God's Word revealed in the book of Colossians. The Gnostics claimed to have a super-knowledge. Paul said: *"you should have epignosis instead."*
- IV. A general description of Gnosticism:
 - 1. Gnosticism begins with a dualism good versus evil.
 - 2. The question in Gnosticism is "How are you going to save man, since matter is evil?" They said there were two ways to do it:
 - Maximum asceticism (denial of self) or
 - Maximum lasciviousness (living it up)
- V. Gnosticism Salvation was in one area achieved by abstaining from food, drink, marriage. This was asceticism. Lasciviousness said that the world of the pleroma (world of the spirits) were liberated by the phallic cult. (The immorality among the Greeks.) These are called Nicolaitans in <u>Rev. 2:6</u>. Both of these systems are wrong salvation by works!
- VI. Gnosticism was both an experiential and philosophical attack upon the Word of God. Their conclusion: Revelation is apart from the Canon. Also ritual and sacrifices must be included. This concept has been perpetuated from the first century up to this present time (worship services with symbols and rituals). Angels were also worshipped (<u>Col. 2:8</u>).
