## God's System of Learning (GSL)

## EPHESIANS 1:18

- 1. Each perceptive Believer desires to study and comprehend the Truth of God's Word.
- 2. Our God has provided that which is necessary to properly hear, receive, and comprehend the mind of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3. First, we have been given a mind, the ability to receive information, and the ability (when utilizing God's System of Learning), of comprehending truth for the soul. This is Eph.1:18 "the eyes of the heart enlightened".
- 4. At Salvation we became the recipient of regeneration when God worked the miracle of His imputed Righteousness. This is the gift of the Indwelling of the Holy Spirit. "Christ in you the hope of Glory" Col. 1:27

Study here the **Greek translation of Colossians 1:27** 

5. I Cor.2:10-13 reveals that we as born again individuals, in this Age of Grace, have received a receptacle (an invisible storage place called the human spirit) along with all the ingredients necessary to grow up.

## God's System of Learning (GSL) (Continued)

- 6. Spiritual maturity should be the goal of every believer. Eph.4:14, 15.
- 7. When we comprehend the Word of God in our minds, receiving it while in harmony, it becomes "gnosis" which is knowledge.
- 8. Then, when we mix the promises with faith (trust, confidence) (Heb.4:2) it becomes usable, applied knowledge which is described as "Epignosis" ( I Cor.2:12) which means "over and above knowledge.
- 9. Eph.3:19 exhort "And to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God."
- 10. FOR THE WORD OF GOD TO BE ANYTHING MORE THAN INTELLECTUAL COMPREHENSION, IT MUST BE BELIEVED AND APPLIED ON A MOMENT BY MOMENT BASIS.
- 11. I Cor.2:1-16 gives a distinction between human IQ and spiritual IQ.
- 12. I Cor.1:19-21 and I Cor.2:9 excludes human IQ from God's System of Learning.
