 1. Jeremiah was instructed to “*stand in the gate of the Lord’s house*” (7:2)
 2. “*Amend your ways and your deeds*” (7:3)
 3. “*Do not trust deceptive words*” (7:4)
- VIII. A PROPHET WITH A BROKEN HEART – *CHAPTER 9:1-15*
 1. A man in sorrow over the futility of his proclamation being abandoned. The people had turned to everything vile and wicked. (8:6, 7; 9:2-9)
 2. He weeps day and night at the thought of impending retribution. He begs, pleads, entreats, implores the people to turn from their wickedness but all seems to be in vain.
 3. Even the threat of Babylonian invasion spurred the people of Judah to great activity but it was the manufacture of idols, as if idols could save them.
 4. Jeremiah’s preaching was a reminder that the people were far from pleasing their God.
