

Love and Character

NOTE HERE:

1. A person's love for another person is no stronger than the character of the one initiating love. When a person says: "*I love you*" – that statement is based on the character of that individual! If the person's character is weak – then the statement is weak.
2. What about the character of Jesus? His character was perfect. He initiated love toward you and me.
3. No matter how much we love Christ, our love cannot match His Love. No verbal expression is sufficient. The soul must be filled to express meaningful love. Doing is not knowing, though we do not de-emphasize doing *as a result of knowing*.
