## Many Old Testament Conversions Recorded

Many Gentiles were saved in the Old Testament .The citizens of Nineveh responded to the Gospel when Jonah preached to them (Matt. 12:41; Luke 11:32; Rom. 9:24, 25; Rom. 9: 30-33).

Job gave perfect testimony to salvation in Gospel form – death, burial and resurrection (Job 19:23-27).

Daniel regarded the salvation of Nebuchadnezzar (Daniel 4:11-18; 4:34): "My understanding returned to me". Then, in verses 36, 37, we see seven years of insanity to learn the truth of God.

Noah was declared "just" in Gen. 6:8, 9, and was said to have righteousness in Heb. 11:7. Hebrews 11 shows the spiritual life of Old Testament believers.

The Old Testament imputation of righteousness is revealed in Psalm 24:5 and Isaiah 61:10.
