

New Testament Time Line

AGE OF ISRAEL INTERRUPTED

JESUS BORN IN AGE OF ISRAEL

HYPOSTATIC UNION

GOD IN FLESH

About 4 BC – 30 AD

1. Jesus – Deity 2 became God in the flesh – Son of God – undiminished Deity and PERFECT HUMANITY in ONE PERSON FOREVER.
2. He lived, died, was resurrected and ascended – AGE OF ISRAEL!
3. THE CHURCH AGE – DISPENSATION OF GRACE – interrupted the age of Israel.
4. All believers from Pentecost on – received Universal Indwelling making the Divine System of LOVE available to each believer. (Body, Soul, Spirit)
5. The Bible was penned from approximately 45 until 96 AD. The Apostle John was God's instrument to write 1st, 2nd, and 3rd John around 60 – 65 AD, the Gospel of John between 85 – 95 AD and the book of Revelation about 96 AD.

New Testament Time Line (Continued)

6. The writings of Paul came between 48 and 69 AD – Galatians, Corinthians, Thessalonians, Romans between 50 and 60 AD.
7. Colossians, Ephesians, Philippians, Philemon, Timothy and Titus in the 60's.
8. Please note here that God used the Apostle Paul to write before the destruction of Jerusalem which came in 70 AD and in the earlier part of the PRE-CANON period.
9. The Synoptic writers (Matthew, Mark and Luke) wrote between 50 and 60 AD.
10. Since the Bible had not been completely written, God gave the Apostle some identification privileges (marks – temporary credit cards – to assure people that he was legitimately from God – such as the gift of healing, tongues, interpretation of tongues, etc.)
11. The temporary gifts had two purposes:
 - 1) One was to evangelize Jews in Gentile languages
 - 2) To warn the Jews relative to the discipline ahead by unbelief.
