# Philippians 1:6

6 For I am **confident** of this very thing, that He who **began** a good work in you will **accomplish** it until the day of Christ Jesus.

confident- πείθω - (pf.act.ptcp.) to cause to come to a particular point of view from the result of God's work

began - ἐνάρχομαι - (aor.mid.ptcp.) to start, commence, to begin

Accomplish - ἐπιτελέσει - (fut.act.ind.) – accomplish, complete, perfect, to bring about a result according to plan or objective

# Divine Good

- ἔργον ἀγαθόν”
- Phase 2
  - Glorify God in your body! (imperative mood, it's a command!)
- 1 Cor 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? 20 For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.
- The only way to glorify God is to use His resources to grow up and produce a maximum amount of divine good in this life

- Of perfect quality

- Philippians 1:9      9And this is my prayer: that your love **may abound** more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, 10so that you may be able to **discern what is best** and in order to **be pure and blameless for the day of Christ**, 11filled with the fruit of **righteousness** that comes through **Jesus Christ**—to the **glory and praise of God**.
