confident- πείθω - (pf.act.ptcp.) to cause to come to a particular point of view from the result of God's work began - ἐνάρχομαι - (aor.mid.ptcp.) to start, commence, to begin

Accomplish - ἐπιτελέσει - (fut.act.ind.) – accomplish, complete, perfect, to bring about a result according to plan or objective

- Phase 2
 - Glorify God in your body! (imperative mood, it's a command!)
- 1 Cor 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? 20 For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.
