<u>Pleroo – πληρόω, 11 Ways and a Conclusion</u>

- Pleroo is used for Growth the construction of the spiritual house of the soul (SHS) in the Humanity of Jesus Christ. By the time He was 11 or 12 in his earthly life He had reached the Echo Zone (EZ). (Luke 2:40)
- 2. The same verb is used in Eph. 3:19; 4:10; Col. 1:9 for the construction of the Spiritual house in the Church Age believer.
- 3. The verb is also used for the believer being controlled by the Holy Spirit in Eph. 5:18.
- 4. Pleroo is used for God's perfect happiness in the Believer, as that believer gets to the mountain peak of the EZ. (Phil. 2:2; I John 1:4; John 16:24; 17:13)
- 5. Pleroo is used for the production of Vertical Good in Phil. 1:11.
- 6. Pleroo is used for the Pastor who communicates faithfully the Word of God to his right congregation. (Col. 1:25)
- 7. Pleroo is used for the Freedom of the Believer through Positional Truth. (Col. 2:10)
- 8. Pleroo is used for the financial security of the Pastor through giving, whereby he is able to devote time to the study and communication of the Word. (Phil. 4:18)
- 9. Pleroo is used for the completed structure of the SHS. I John 1:4 "And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full" (Pf.P.Subj of πλερόω)
- 10. Pleroo is used for the fulfillment of Christ through the Church under the analogy of right man-right woman. (Eph. 1:23)
- 11. Pleroo is used for the failure to detect any Echo Zone believers in the local Church. (Rev. 3:2 The Lord could not find any EZ believers in the Church at Sardis).
- 12. Every believer has some deficiency; therefore, daily spiritual advance is absolutely essential.
