Components of The Salvation Framework

<u>Propitiation</u> – This is the work of Jesus Christ toward God. Jesus' sacrifice on the cross propitiated or satisfied the righteous claim of God against fallen humanity.

- 1 John 2:2 God is satisfied with the work of the cross such that it covers everyone's sins.
- 1 John 4:10 Jesus' purpose in humanity was to be the propitiation for our sins.
- Romans 3:23-26 Believers are justified by the work of Jesus on the cross.

<u>Redemption</u> – This is the work of the Lord Jesus Christ toward sin. By His sacrifice, He paid the penalty for sin and redeemed us from the slave market of sin.

- Ephesians 1:7 Jesus provides redemption for sin.
- Galatians 1:4 It was God's will for us to be redeemed.
- John 3:16 Redemption from sin provides eternal life for believers.

<u>Reconciliation</u> – This is the work of Jesus Christ toward man. Jesus broke down the barrier between God and man that had existed since the fall and thus reconciled man to God.

- Romans 5:10 Jesus provides the reconciliation for the believer.
- Colossians 1:19, 20 God reconciles everything back to Himself via Jesus' work.
