## The Sin Nature (Romans 5:19)

- 1. Adam's one initial sin caused him to fall depraved, degenerate, and his posterity is like his fallen self.
- Every child of Adam is born with the Adamic nature, and, though this nature was judged by Christ on the Cross (Rom. 6:10), it remains a vitally active force in every believer's life.
- 3. It is never said to be removed or eradicated in this life, but there is for the believer overcoming power provided (Rom. 8:4; Gal. 5:16, 17).
- 4. Both imputed sin and the sin nature are the direct result of Adam's one initial sin.
- 5. There is the immediate cause of death and an imparted sin nature by inheritance.
