Soul - Summary

- 1. We are born with an old sinful nature (OSN) Eph. 2:1; Rom. 5:12 (Note here the <u>Greek / Literal Translation of Romans 5:12</u>)
- 2. Adam was not created with an OSN. God is not the author of sin.
- 3. Adam and Eve were created from that point all others perpetuated.
- 4. When Adam sinned his spirit died, and at that point, he received an OSN.
- 5. The body is the house for the soul. The real you is not the body; the real you is the soul and spirit.
- 6. Distinction must be made between the body and the spirit. I Thess. 5:23; Heb. 4:12
- 7. The lost individual is described in I Cor. 2:14 psuchikos
- 8. When the lost person dies, his soul continues to exist no destruction or annihilation and no purification.
- 9. At birth, there is a prefabricated (constructed beforehand) place for life which is the soul.
- 10. At birth, because of depravity (the fall of man Adam's sin) there is a place (prefabricated) for the imputation of Adam's Original Sin. The place is called the OSN. This spells condemnation; and had there been no condemnation at birth, there could be no potential of salvation at God consciousness. Jesus Christ took our condemnation on the Cross and was judged for us A judicial judgment. GOD IMPUTED TO US ADAM'S SIN, SO THAT HE COULD IMPUTE TO JESUS CHRIST OUR PERSONAL SINS.
