Spiritual House of the Soul

- 1. This is an unseen, invisible house, in the soul (mind). Heb. 6:19; 10:16
- 2. This invisible house can only be constructed by the truths of the Word of God. | Corinthians 3:16; 6:19; 2 Corinthians 6:16
- 3. This construction is NOT in every believer's soul.
- 4. This construction is built gradually-slowly-like the building of an earthly house.
- 5. When this edifice is built then there will be something inside to give "SPIRITUAL THINKING ABILITY" RESULTING IN STABILITY AND MATURITY. Heb. 6:19
- 6. With this construction it is still possible to get out of fellowship and act like an unbeliever
- 7. There are different names for this construction:
 - a. Imitators of Christ
 - b. Πλεροω: (play-row-o) filled full
 - c. "Christ at home in your heart" Eph. 3:17
 - d. "put on a new man" Eph. 4:23, 24
- 8. Each person must choose to construct his own Spiritual edifice in his own soul, and this takes consistency and persistence.
- 9. This means making decisions daily to receive the mind of Jesus Christ by learning His Doctrinal precepts.
- 10. Spiritual momentum is gained by making right decisions which results in true worship having an altar in the soul.

Heb. 10:16b "...I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them."

Prov. 24:3a "Through wisdom is a house built...and by understanding it is established."

Prov. 24:4 "... By knowledge shall the chambers (of this edifice) be filled with all precious and pleasant riches."
