

# The Risen Savior

The resurrection of the Lord Jesus was unique in that He was the first human being to come back to life with a changed and glorified body, eternal and immortal in nature (1 Cor.15:20; 1 Tim.6:16) All three members of the Trinity had a part in the resurrection of our Lord:

- God the Father ([Romans 6:4](#); [Galatians 1:1](#))
- God the Son ([John 10:18](#))
- God the HS ([Romans 8:11](#); [1 Peter 3:18](#))

Because He rose, we, too, shall be raised and have bodies like that of the Son of God ([1 Corinthians 15:52-53](#); [Philippians 3:20-21](#))
