## <u>Truth – Veracity (Accuracy, Correctness)</u>

## John 8:32 "You shall know."

- I. Greek words for truth in the New Testament logos, (λόγοσ); didache, (διδαχή); didaskalia, (διδασκαλία) and aletheia (ἀλήτηεια).
- II. Hebrew words for truth in the Old Testament Chakma, Emet, Shamooah, and Moosarr.
- III. The last word that Jesus spoke when dying was the word truth in Psalm 31:5 which is quoted in Luke 23:46. "Into your hands I deposit my spirit for you have delivered me, O Jehovah, God of TRUTH."
- IV. Bible believers like David spoke the truth in Psalm 38:2 "I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy loving kindness for thy TRUTH for thou hast magnified THY WORD above thy reputation."
- V. Truth was in existence before the human race according to Proverbs 8, but not in condensed writing.
- VI. Our attitude toward truth determines whether we will be blessed or cursed (disciplined). Proverbs 8:33-36 "Hear instruction, and be wise, DO NOT REJECT IT."
- VII. Truth is the reason for the distribution of Echo Zone (Isaiah 53:12) and Grace Abounding Blessings in time and Heaven's Grace Blessings in eternity. Heb. 11:9, 10; 11:13; James 1:25; 2:12, 13.
- VIII. Truth in the believer's soul becomes more real than empirical knowledge. II Peter 1:12-21 (Read)
- IX. When a nation fails to abide by the truth of God's Word, that nation is on the road to disaster. Hosea 4:1-6 "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge."
- X. Truth makes it possible for the believer to live with an enlarged capacity for life.
- XI. The pastor is responsible to see to it that the congregation receives the mind of Jesus Christ by faithful dissemination of God's Word. I Cor. 6:19; Eph. 5:18; II Peter 3:18
- XII. Truth brings many results:
  - 1. Confidence; Job 5:24; II Cor. 5: 6, 8
  - 2. Vertical viewpoint; Isaiah 55: 7, 8; II Cor. 10:5
  - 3. Understanding God's will; Isaiah 26: 3, 4; Romans 8:28
  - 4. Stability of mind; James 1:8
  - 5. Great happiness; Phil. 3:10; Eph. 3:10; Heb. 12: 2, 3, 7
