1. Born to the Tribe of Levi ([Exodus 2:1](#))
2. Raised by the Pharaoh's Daughter ([Exodus 2:10](#))
3. Was 40 years old when he killed a man ([Acts 7:23](#))

4. Flees to Midian, where he starts a family ([Exodus 2:21-22](#))

5. He spent 40 years as a shepherd before God called on him

<sup>6</sup> Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

1. God commands Jonah ([Jonah 1:2](#))

2. Jonah flees ([Jonah 1:3](#))
3. The Lord gently corrects Jonah ([Jonah 1:4](#))
4. Jonah waits ([Jonah 1:17](#))
5. Jonah (finally) obeys ([Jonah 3:1-3](#))
6. God spares Nineveh ([Jonah 3:10](#))
